



Youth Voice Manifesto 2024

This event brings together disabled children and young people and those with special educational needs from across England, providing an opportunity to develop their participation skills and to recognise the impact they can have when taking part in strategic participation. Youth Voice Matters is a conference with a difference - designed by young people for young people.

At the Council for Disabled Children, we believe children and young people's right to be heard and to take part in decision-making about their lives should go even further than what the law outlines. We hope Youth Voice Matters gives children and young people a space to develop their confidence and their participation skills, and create share examples of what can happen when children and young people realise their collective power.
